



# School Council Meeting

### **1. Suggestions for School Council**

Arthur showed everyone the suggestion box he made for his class and read out some of the suggestions for the School Council to discuss. Many other councillors had come along with a notebook with ideas and suggestions from classes. All were discussed, but for today's meeting, we need to focus on whether children want to bring back SRS house groups and the house bears.

### **2. SRS Houses and House Bears**

The general consensus is that the children want to bring back SRS houses and the bears! Every councillor had a chance to feedback ideas about what this could look like:

- Extra break time for winning houses
- Points could be awarded to classes who line up the best, or walk around school the quietest, the prefects could judge this
- There could be a teddy bear picnic with the winning house and their bear, maybe in the forest
- Could the bears have new clothes?
- There could be house jars so the points are visible to everyone
- We could have head of houses
- Children could have house badges
- Should we re-name the houses?
- The bears should be displayed somewhere for everyone to see
- Mr Mallender could do surprise class visits to see which classes to award points to
- The bears should have a sports kit for Sports Day

### **3. Remembrance Day**

Mrs Dawson explained that the School Council have been invited to attend a memorial service led by Loughton Town Mayor. For the remainder of the meeting time, we made poppies for a wreath.
